2. WORKSHOP LOCATION AND TRAVEL: Trainings will be held in Fairbanks, Alaska. If you cannot cover travel and lodging expenses let us know and we may be able to help. We have a limited amount of scholarships available. You **MUST** attend **ALL** classes to be eligible for this benefit.

3. COURSE OUTLINE: The following four 5-day trainings are required to complete certificate program:

January 18-22: 40-hour HAZWOPER

February 15-19: HAZWOPER Supervisor, Incident Command System, Emergency Response, First Aid / CPR

March 15-19: Confined Space Entry, State, Local, Federal Guest Speakers, Developing Site Specific Health and Safety Plans

April 19-23: Oil Spill Response, Department of Transportation CFR 49, Final Exam and Hands-on Exercises

May 10-14: Make-up week, if needed

NOTE: *If you can submit proof of completion for any of the above classes, you may be able to receive credit. Contact Chuck Mitchell for details.*

Participants are required to attend all (100%) trainings to be accepted and certified. Instructors will be provided by the University Of Washington. Upon successful completion of all 4 weeks, students will receive a *certificate of attendance*. Once the post-course assignments are completed, successful students will receive their official **Certificate of Completion** issued by the **University of Washington**. **NOTE:** Once you have signed your letter of commitment, you may be held financially responsible for up to \$200 per day, per student for failure to attend or participate in this course.

Space is Limited – Only **25** spots available. Successful candidates will have submitted a **completed registration form, supplementary application form, letter of commitment from an employer, supervisor or tribal administrator** and a **signed agreement to complete all class and assignments**.
