3. COURSE OUTLINE: The following 11 days trainings are required to complete certificate program:

Group 2

March 5-10: 24-hour HAZWOPER, Emergency Response, Confined Space, First Aid/CPR - **NOTE**, this a 6 day week.

April 16-20: DOT (3 days), Oil Spill Awareness, Hands-on Exercise and final written exam. If you can submit proof of completion for any of the above classes, you may be able to receive credit. Contact Chuck Mitchell for details.
